**Small Group Study for Week of January 31- February 6**

**The Big Idea: God calls us to be His Priests in this world. If we will not accept this opportunity and honour, who will?**

**Group Reads:** Isaiah 6:1-8

**Questions:**

1. Why did what Isaiah saw have such an impact on Him?
2. Why did He respond by talking about His unworthiness?
3. When Isaiah (or us) acknowledge our own unworthiness, according to verses 5-7 what happens? How does that make you feel?
4. To every saved person – a person who has gone through the same type of experience Isaiah did receives the same call Isaiah did in verse 8. What does responding to this call mean?

**Group Reads:** 1 Peter 2:4,5 and 9

**Questions:**

1. Who according to these verses are priests?
2. What are priests according to these verses supposed to do? How can we do those things?

**Group Reads:** Ephesians 4:11:13

**Comment:** In Greek the words “service” and “ministry” are the same word. The word “minister” and “servant” are the same word. This means that all of us who are priests or ministers are to minister or serve. If we accept God’s call of who will go – we will accept that we are priests/ministers and have an amazing calling, responsibility, and awesome opportunities.

**Questions:**

1. What is the purpose of do “works of service,” or ministry according to the above verses?
2. What would that look like for us?

**Group Reads:** Ephesians 4:14-16

1. If we as Priests accepted our call, what according to the above verses would be the result?
2. Paul seemed to think correct teaching (another word for doctrine) was important. Why?

**Conclusion:**

Notice we are not supposed to grow up into Christ by ourselves v 16. What does this verse mean? How according to everything we have read in Eph 4 is this going to happen?
