Big Idea

The sermon this week was focussed upon being able to sell the truth of Jesus Christ. But the bottom line we were all left with was, “do we know the author of the book?”

We may not be trained salespeople for God but we are called to live a life that reflects the author of our book. We can study the Bible, we can read the Bible, we can even recite whole chapters but without knowing who God is, it is all totally pointless.

Group to discuss:

How does a person get to know their God?

1. Read Exodus 33:7-11 note vs. 11. How is the Lord described in His speaking to Moses?
2. Read Exodus 33:12-23. What is Moses doing here - how motivated is he to get to know who God is?
3. Seeing verses. 12 and 17 - What is God saying to Moses?

Moses is hungry for a deep and close relation with his God. Especially with the responsibility that he had caring for all those children of Israel.

How serious are you to have God close in your life?

What are you doing to achieve that closeness?

Are you willing to seek God to know you by name?
